



**COVID 19: LEGISLATIVE MEASURES OF
CONTAINMENT ADOPTED IN ITALY
MARCH 12, 2020**

The Italian Government initially adopted containment measures limited to the geographical areas in which the first infection occurred (20 February): closure of the territory without entry and exit permits to anyone manned by the police.

The epidemic quickly expanded dramatically to force the government to take drastic measures such as the current ones which are:

GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR EVERYONE

- Obligation to maintain the distance between people of at least one meter.
- Prohibition of meeting of any kind.
- absolute ban on leaving home for those who are quarantined or tested positive for the virus
- Prohibition of moving even within the same areas where you reside without a reason that must be written (self-certification) and fall in these cases:
 - o proven working needs
 - o situations of necessity;
 - o health reasons;
- or return to your home, home or residence.

The police stop anyone on the street and ask to present this documentation; if it is devoid of it, it is reported.

PROVISIONS FOR WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Stop all direct sales to the consumer, except for the sale of food and basic necessities;
- The activities of catering services are suspended (including bars, pubs, restaurants, ice cream parlors, patisseries)
- Only catering with home delivery remains permitted
- Banking, financial and insurance services, as well as the agricultural, zootechnical agro-food processing sector, including the supply chains that supply goods and services, are guaranteed, in compliance with hygiene and health regulations.
- Obligation to implement the maximum use by companies of agile working methods for activities that can be carried out at home or remotely;



- Incentive holidays and paid leave for employees as well as other tools provided for in collective bargaining;
- SUSPEND the activities of the company departments not indispensable for production;
- ASSUME anti-contagion safety protocols and, where it is not possible to respect the interpersonal distance of one meter as the main containment measure, with the adoption of individual protection tools (masks with FP2 or FP3 filter)
- sanitization operations in the workplace are encouraged, also using forms of social safety nets for this purpose;
- for production activities only, it is also recommended that movements within the sites are limited and access to common areas is limited.

Pay attention: is not recommended surgery masks because they are considered not useful for an optimal protection of saliva microdrops



**ALL SHOPS WHO COULD STAY OPENED
MUST RESPECT THE FOLLOWING RULES:**

- the individual safety distance of one meter must always be respected between operators and between customers and between customers and operators.



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- The owner or manager of the shop must enforce it and must take measures so that there is never a crowding in the shop that decreases this distance.
- Must make available to the public disinfectant gel or hydroalcoholic solution to disinfect hands.
- It must frequently disinfect the surfaces with which people come into contact or micro drops of saliva (sales counters, handles, etc.) may settle on them.
- The maximum opening time is from 6.00 AM to 6.00: in the event of subsequent opening, strong penalties are foreseen until the business closes for several days.

IT IS MANDATORY TO EXPOSE IN ALL WORKING AREAS AND IN ALL THE PLACES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC SIGNS AND NOTICES TO PUBLICIZE TO THE MAXIMUM THE SANITARY SANITARY RULES THAT EVERYONE SHOULD FOLLOW
